Garden Boxes

Strings line vegetable rows and act as a navigational aid 3ft x 4ft garden boxes surrounding crops so I know where to weed Box limits area needed to weed



Garden Strings

Rope running down the right hand side of each row Allows for easy navigation when locating rows and mowing/weeding



Orchard

Trees evenly spaced and ropes used to navigate when mowing/weeding Three rows of trees, 12 ft apart



Using Cane to find trees Orchard starts at picket fence

Orchard starts at picket fence Trees are approximately 8-10 feet from fence Once fence is located, reed pole is used to locate tree(s)



Mowing along tree lines

String provides navigation aid while marking where trees are located



Mowing along fence line

Fence is used as a guide for navigating Left hand touches fence Pull mower backwards with right hand



Cattle

Reed Cane is used to locate the trough Raise 8-12 feeder calves each year





Retired guide dog Guides me down ¼ mile driveway to mailbox and to take out trash



Young trees sectioned and separated by rope

View of young trees lining property Strings lines the tree rows for easy navigation



Tractor Wife (Lee) operates tractor and other heavy machinery.



Tape Measure

Description of tape measure and how it is read Marked at every 16" and 2 ft using raised dots
