The Problem - Students are working at a disadvantage

Students (both with and without disabilities) would benefit from the accessibility features built into Windows and macOS that would help them in their schoolwork, but they are not using them* because

1. **They don't know that the features even exist**
2. **The features are buried** in the settings/control panels, and they are too hard to find and use
3. **They are afraid to go into the settings** because they get lost, are afraid they will break something, or have been told to stay away from the settings on school computers

The result is that those students who would benefit from these features **are working at a disadvantage to their peers when using the computers at school.**

Free Solution - Morpic

Morphic is a free open-source tool that takes key built-in accessibility features that are buried in the settings or control panels and displays them on a toolbar for students to easily discover and use.

(The MorpicBar's menu also makes it easy to access all the rest of the accessibility features as well).



The MorpicBar features are not new. All are existing features that are built into Windows or macOS. The MorpicBar just makes them easier to discover, access and use.

Benefits

This tool benefits

- Students with low vision (even moderate low vision)
- Students who have trouble reading for any reason (Dyslexia being only one)
- Students with color vision differences ("color blindness") (as high as 1 in 12 males)
- Students who have trouble physically selecting small things like fine lines on edges
- Many students without disabilities who would benefit from accessibility / usability features.
